**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to obstructed views while driving.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following sentence:- A violation of
3 this section for the presence of 1 or more small items hanging from the rearview mirror of a
4 motor vehicle in operation shall only be enforced by law enforcement agencies when an operator
5 of a motor vehicle has been stopped for some other violation of the motor vehicle laws or some
6 other offense.
