**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to 100% disabled veteran recreation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule or regulation to the contrary, any
- 2 Massachusetts resident who is a 100 percent disabled veteran shall be entitled to any hunting or
- 3 fishing license offered by the Commonwealth without fee or cost.
