An Act expanding career and technical education opportunities for Lynn students.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any independent  
2   distributive occupations schools located in the City of Lynn may offer instruction in part time  
3   and evening classes whereas attendance upon such day or part time classes shall be restricted to  
4   those of at least thirteen years of age; and upon such evening classes, to those over sixteen years  
5   of age.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
