An Act increasing the membership of the board of health of the town of Marblehead from three members to five.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the number of  
2   members of the board of health of the town of Marblehead shall be increased from 3 members to  
3   5 members, with the select board annually electing a chairperson from among its members.

4           SECTION 2. At the first annual town election to occur following the effective date of this  
5   act, 3 board of health members shall be elected. The candidate receiving the highest number of  
6   votes in that election shall serve a 3-year term. The candidate receiving the second highest  
7   number of votes shall serve a 2-year term. The candidate receiving the third highest number of  
8   votes shall serve a 1-year term. Thereafter, as the terms of the board members expire, successors  
9   shall be elected for terms of 3 years.

10          SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
