### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to teacher strikes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 9A of chapter 150E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-
- 3 (c) Whenever a public employee or public employees engaged in a strike are public
- 4 school employees, the school district that employs the public employees
- 5 shall: (i) not reduce or eliminate the hours established by the school district's school year
- 6 schedule pursuant to 603 CMR 27.03; and (ii) maintain structured learning time requirements
- 7 pursuant to 603 CMR 27.04.
