An Act relative to physician relocation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 2D and 2 inserting in place thereof the following section:-
- 3 Section 2D. (a) No contract or agreement which creates or establishes a partnership,
- 4 employment, affiliation, grant of privileges or any other form of professional relationship with a
- 5 physician for the purpose of the physician engaging in medical practice or providing medical
- 6 services may include terms that:
- 7 (i) prohibit a physician from providing testimony in an administrative or judicial hearing,
- 8 including cases of medical malpractice; or
- 9 (ii) prohibit a physician from providing patients with information about other locations
- where the physician currently engages in medical practice or will be engaging in medical
- 11 practice in the future.

- 12 (b) Inclusion of such terms in any contract or agreement shall be deemed to constitute an
- unfair method of competition and unfair or deceptive act or practice and subject to all remedies
- set forth in chapter 93A.
