## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to insurance settlements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (1) of section 48 of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the following 3 3 sentences:- The employer shall be notified in writing of such payment by the insurer by way of a 4 lump sum agreement and shall have 30 days to consent in writing or object in writing to the lump 5 sum agreement. After the passage of 30 days, if the employer does not object or consent in 6 writing to the proposed lump sum agreement, then the employer's consent is not required. In this 7 event the insurer shall file an affidavit, to be attached to the lump sum agreement papers as an 8 exhibit that states: (i) the employer has been notified of the proposed lump sum agreement; (ii) 9 no written objection has been received by the employer; and (iii) 30 days has passed from the 10 date of mailing of the notice to the employer.
