**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to the race horse development fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the comptroller shall transfer
2 up to \$10,000,000 each fiscal year, if the secretary of administration and finance requests in
3 writing, from the Race Horse Development Fund established in section 60 of chapter 23K of the
4 General Laws to the Community Preservation Trust Fund established in section 9 of chapter 44B
5 of the General Laws.
