An Act relative to fees at health clubs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 80 of chapter 93 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the last paragraph the following:-

3           “If a buyer becomes physically or medically disabled for a period in excess of three  
4 months during the membership term, he or she shall have the option to be relieved of liability for  
5 payment on that portion of the contract term for which the buyer is disabled, or to extend the  
6 duration of the contract at no additional cost for a period equal to the duration of the disability.

7           No contract shall impose any type of fee for a period of three months if the buyer  
8 becomes physically and medically disabled and the disability is verified by a licensed physician.”
