**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to cardholder surcharges.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 28A of chapter 140D of the General Laws, is amended by striking out, in line 7-
2 9, the words "(2) No seller in any sales transaction may impose a surcharge on a cardholder who
3 elects to use a credit card in lieu of payment by cash, check or similar means." and replace it with
4 the following words: "(2) A seller in any sales transaction may impose a surcharge of one half of
5 the processing fee on a cardholder who elects to use a credit card or debit card in lieu of payment
6 by cash, check or similar means. The charging of the surcharge fee shall be clearly stated on the
7 bill or invoice prior to payment."
