**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to the town resident requirement for the town manager of the town of Dalton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 5 of chapter 137 of the acts of 1995 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the words “and, although he need not be a resident of the town or
3 commonwealth when appointed, shall become a resident of the town within one year after
4 appointment”.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
