By Representative Consalvo of Boston, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Rob Consalvo that the Department of Conservation and Recreation be authorized to designate the tennis courts located in Weider Park in the Roslindale section of the city of Boston as the Kim O’Connell tennis courts. **In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court

An Act designating the Weider Park tennis courts as the Kim O'Connell tennis courts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tennis courts located in Weider Park managed by the department of
2 conservation and recreation located in the Roslindale section of the city of Boston at the corner
3 of Dale Street and Sherrin Street shall be formally known as the Kim O’Connell Tennis Courts
4 named after Kim O’Connell for her many years of dedicated service to her neighborhood.

5 SECTION 2. The Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation shall erect
6 and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the
7 department.
