**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act authorizing the town of Milford to convert a license for the sale of wine and malt beverages into a license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be consumed on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 289 of the Acts of 2022 is hereby amended by striking
2 out, in subsection (a), the words “wine and malt beverages” and inserting in place thereof the
3 words:- all alcoholic beverages.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
