**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court  
(2025-2026)**

An Act eliminating the preliminary election in the city of Revere in 2025.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there shall not  
2 be a preliminary election in the city of Revere, as otherwise required, on September 16, 2025 for  
3 the office of school committee for a 2-year term or for the office of city council for a 2-year  
4 term. The candidates for those offices whose nomination papers have been duly certified shall  
5 be deemed to have been nominated and their names shall appear on the general election ballot.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
