Worrell (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to authorize Alex J. Rodriguez to take the civil service examination for the position of police officer in the city of Boston notwithstanding the maximum age requirement. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

An Act directing the city of Boston Police Department to waive the maximum age requirement for police officers for Alex J. Rodriguez.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1.

2 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, including the provisions of
3 Chapter 43 of the Acts of 2007, the City of Boston Police Department shall waive the maximum
4 age requirement for original appointment of police officers for Alex J. Rodriguez. If Alex J.
5 Rodriguez meets all other requirements set forth by the Boston Police Department, he shall be
6 eligible to have his name certified for original appointment to the position of police officer.

7 SECTION 2.

8 This act shall take effect upon its passage.
