An Act clarifying the existing pipefitting exemption.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 87 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting, in line 12, after the word "employed" the following words:
- 3 "nor shall such provisions apply to such pipefitting performed by a person in the employ
- 4 of a contractor or subcontractor, retained by one of the above organizations, for any work
- 5 required on the organization's premises or property."
