An Act regarding the appointment of Special Police Officers in the City of Malden.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 1 of Chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other  
2 general or special law to the contrary, including the provisions of Chapter 17 of the Acts of 2018,  
3 the maximum age of eligibility for a retired Malden Police Officer to be appointed to the position  
4 of Special Police Officers in the City of Malden shall be seventy (70) years of age.

5           SECTION 2. All other provisions of Chapter 17 of the Acts of 2018 shall remain in full  
6 force and effect.

7           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
