The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to limited liability company fees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, any
- 2 limited liability company (LLC) business in the commonwealth whose revenues from the prior
- 3 fiscal year do not exceed \$50,000 shall pay a renewal fee of \$100 annually for any such year.
- 4 Such LLC businesses shall pay the standard fee required by the office of the secretary of state in
- 5 their first year of incorporation.
