## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court  
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to the reserve time of public safety personnel in the city of Salem.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding paragraph (o) of subdivision (1) and paragraphs (b) and (c)  
2 of subdivisions (2) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws or any other general or special  
3 law to the contrary, and in order to promote the public good, the Salem Retirement Board shall  
4 provide creditable service for reserve, permanent-intermittent, or call service of certain public  
5 safety personnel employed either by the City of Salem's Police Department or Fire Department,  
6 who became members of the Salem Retirement System on or before February 11, 2020, without  
7 payment for such creditable service.

8 SECTION 2. This bill shall take effect upon its passage
