An Act relative to extending the timeframe within which the town of Southbridge may grant additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (e) of section 1 of chapter 214 of the acts of 2022, is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the date “December 31, 2025” and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following date:- January 2, 2029.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
