An Act designating the Dorchester division of the Boston municipal court as the Judge Leslie E. Harris courthouse.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The courthouse of the Dorchester division of the Boston municipal court located at 510  
2   Washington street in the city of Boston shall be designated and known as the Judge Leslie E.  
3   Harris courthouse, in honor of the late Honorable Leslie Earl Harris, a former judge of the  
4   Suffolk juvenile court, for his many contributions to his community, the judiciary and the  
5   commonwealth. The division of capital asset management and maintenance shall erect and  
6   maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with any applicable standards.
