An Act to expand the Massachusetts School Building Authority and create a new program to assist public school districts with 21st century technology upgrades.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 70B of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 Section 21. The authority shall create a technology upgrade program for school districts  
3 to provide partial funding throughout the commonwealth for school technology upgrades. The  
4 technology upgrade program shall be a competitive grant program and its grants shall be  
5 distributed by the authority on the basis of need and urgency. The authority shall maintain  
6 funding for all capital programs in existence on January 1, 2025 in an amount equal to or greater  
7 than the funding for said programs in fiscal year 2025.
