The committee on Transportation, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3626) of David Biele for legislation to authorize the MBTA to establish a reduced fare program for veterans; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3635) of Tackey Chan relative to establishing toll discounts on the Massachusetts Turnpike, Ted Williams Tunnel and the Tobin Bridge for persons sixty-five years of age or older; the joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3646) of Leigh Davis for legislation to establish the quarterly allocation of Chapter 90 funds for cities and towns; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3647) of Leigh Davis relative to expenditures for maintaining, repairing, improving, and constructing municipal ways and bridges and other eligible municipal projects, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5134) ought to be adopted.

1           *Ordered,* That the committee on Transportation be authorized to sit during a recess of the  
2 General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents numbered 3626, 3635,  
3 3646 and 3647, relative to tolls and fares.

4           Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study  
5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
7 on or before December 31, 2026.
