Cabral for legislation to fund public transit expansion including the establishment of certain fees; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3651) of Vincent Lawrence Dixon for legislation to encourage local service delivery of Registry of Motor Vehicle services; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3668) of Jessica Ann Giannino and Jeffrey Rosario Turco relative to expanding certain discount tolls for private passenger vehicles owned by residents of the cities of Revere and Chelsea, the town of Winthrop and Essex County; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3717) of Michael P. Kushmerek for legislation to further regulate the distribution of transportation funds, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5142) ought to be adopted.

2 General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents numbered 3633, 3651,
3 3668 and 3717, relative to transportation financing mechanisms.

4 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study
5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
7 on or before December 31, 2026.
