Gordon relative to senior property tax deferrals; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3120) of James K. Hawkins and Steven S. Howitt for legislation to provide municipalities with the option to freeze residential tax rate or valuation for the elderly with means tested criteria; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3235) of Adam J. Scanlon and Simon Cataldo relative to tax relief for low-income seniors and veterans; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3241) of Adam J. Scanlon relative to establishing a senior property tax deferral pilot program; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3272) of Tommy Vitolo and David M. Rogers relative to senior property tax deferral; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3968) of William F. MacGregor relative to property tax exemptions for seniors and persons with disabilities; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4027) of Bruce J. Ayers relative to motor vehicle excise tax exemptions for persons with disabilities, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5164) ought to be adopted.

1           *Ordered,* That the committee on Revenue be authorized to sit during a recess of the  
2 General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents numbered 3114, 3120,  
3 3235, 3241, 3272, 3968 and 4027, relative to tax issues for seniors, veterans and persons with  
4 disabilities.

5           Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study  
6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
8 on or before December 31, 2026.
