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1 *Ordered,* That the committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security be authorized to
2 sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents
3 numbered 2580 and 2738, relative to federal immigration enforcement and police dogs.

4 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study
5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
7 on or before December 31, 2026.
