Saunders (by vote of the town) that the town of Ludlow be authorized to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be consumed on premises in said town. Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure. [Local Approval Received.]

An Act authorizing the town of Ludlow to grant an additional all alcohol license for on premises consumption.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
2 licensing authority of the town of Ludlow may grant three (3) additional all-alcohol licenses for
3 on-premises consumption pursuant to section 15 of said chapter 138. The license shall be subject
4 to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

5 (b} Upon its initial issuance, the licensing authority of the town of Ludlow may approve
6 the transfer of the license granted pursuant to this act to any other location and it may grant a
7 license to a new applicant at the same location if the applicant files with the licensing authority a
8 letter from the department of revenue and a letter from the department of unemployment
9 assistance indicating that the license is in good standing with those departments and that all
10 applicable taxes, fees and contributions have been paid.

11 (c) If the license granted pursuant to this act is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use at
12 the location of original issuance, it shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights,
13 privileges and restrictions pertaining thereto, to the licensing authority and the licensing
14 authority may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same location under the same
15 conditions as specified in this act.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
