An Act authorizing the city of Cambridge to allow for a personal property tax exemption of \$30,000 or less.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding clause Fifty-fourth of section 5 of chapter 59 of the
2 General Laws or any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the city of
3 Cambridge shall be permitted to allow for exemption from taxation of personal property not in
4 excess of \$30,000 of value.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
