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In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)

An Act relative to home care services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 19A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2024
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting before the second to last paragraph the
3 following paragraph:-

4 The department shall ensure that home care program services are made available to
5 persons diagnosed with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis regardless of their age if they are otherwise
6 eligible for such services.

7 SECTION 2. The secretary of health and human services shall ensure that the relevant
8 agencies under their purview, including the department of aging and independence, shall
9 promulgate regulations as necessary to implement this act.
