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In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)

An Act establishing a Medal of Fidelity license plate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 67B of chapter 33 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2024
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Qualifying next of kin of a fallen service member may apply to the adjutant general for a
4 medal of fidelity, in a form prescribed by the adjutant general. There shall be within the
5 application for the medal of fidelity a notice that informs applicants of their eligibility to receive
6 the medal of fidelity license plate, pursuant to section 2 of chapter 90, free of charge upon
7 approval of the application. The notification shall read as follows: “IF YOU RECEIVE THE
8 MEDAL OF FIDELITY, YOU ARE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE MEDAL OF FIDELITY
9 LICENSE PLATE FREE OF CHARGE” and shall include a link to the online application
10 established by the registrar of motor vehicles.

11 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
12 amended by inserting after the twenty-third paragraph the following paragraph:-

13 The registrar shall furnish without charge to owners of private passenger motor vehicles
14 who have been awarded the medal of fidelity pursuant to section 67B of chapter 33 upon
15 presentation of satisfactory evidence of such status, as determined by the registrar, distinctive
16 registration plates for 1 private passenger motor vehicle owned and principally used by such
17 recipient, bearing on the left side an image of the medal and ribbon and bearing the words
18 “MEDAL OF FIDELITY” along the bottom. The registrar, in consultation with the adjutant
19 general of the Massachusetts national guard, shall notify all past recipients of the medal of
20 fidelity, established pursuant to said section 67B of said chapter 33, of their eligibility for the
21 medal of fidelity license plate through a letter, which shall include the application for the medal
22 of fidelity license plate.

23 SECTION 3. Not later than 6 months after the medal of fidelity license plate is designed
24 and in circulation, the registrar of motor vehicles, in consultation with the adjutant general of the
25 Massachusetts national guard shall notify past recipients of the medal of fidelity concerning their
26 eligibility for the medal of fidelity license plate.
