Kassner relative to including accessory dwelling units in subsidized housing inventory; the joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4410) of Hadley Luddy and Julian Cyr relative to funding housing and mitigating investor real estate in seasonal communities; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4411) of Hadley Luddy and Thomas W. Moakley relative to housing in seasonal communities, reports (under the provisions of House Rule 27) recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5647) ought to be adopted.
