Comerford (by vote of the town) that the town of Athol be authorized to grant five additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk off the premises in said town. An Act authorizing the town of Athol to grant five (5) additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk off the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
2 licensing authority of the town of Athol may grant five (5) additional licenses for the sale of all
3 alcoholic beverages to be drunk off the premises pursuant to section 15 of said chapter 138. A
4 license granted pursuant to this act shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section
5 17.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
