An Act relative to science curriculum standards.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 1D of Chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 31, after the word "States" the  
3 following:-

4           The standards for the subject of science shall include only peer-reviewed and age-  
5 appropriate subject matter; provided, (1) peer-reviewed subject matter shall be defined as  
6 conducted in compliance with accepted scientific methods; and (2) age-appropriate shall be  
7 defined as topics, messages, and teaching methods suitable to particular ages or age groups of  
8 children and adolescents, based on developing cognitive, emotional, and behavioral capacity  
9 typical for the age or age group.
