**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act providing curriculum transparency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1E of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by striking out the final sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:-

3 A copy of the frameworks shall be submitted to the joint committee on education, arts
4 and humanities, and made publicly available on the board’s website, at least 60 days prior to
5 taking effect.
