**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to mail-in ballots.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 45 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 An official voting ballot and the accompanying papers shall be mailed postage prepaid
4 and with return postage guaranteed to each registered voter or, if the voter so requests, delivered
5 when called for at the office of the clerk, except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of section
6 91B.
