An Act dedicating certain park and field space in the South Boston section of the city of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The park managed by the department of conservation and recreation located in the South  
2 Boston section of the City of Boston between Farragut Road and Day Boulevard and East  
3 Broadway and Shore Road shall be formally known as Admiral David G. Farragut Park.  
4 Additionally, the football field behind Joseph R. Evans Memorial Field running from Francis L.  
5 Murphy Memorial Rink to Shore Road shall be designated in memory of Walter Rosher and  
6 Gerard McCarthy. The department shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing the  
7 appropriate distinctions for said park and field.
