## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to community colleges and the career technical initiative.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or session law to the contrary, community
2	colleges as defined in Section 10 of Chapter 15A of the Massachusetts General Laws may apply
3	for grant funding from the Career Technical Initiative operated by the Commonwealth
4	Corporation for the purpose of building out industry-recognized credentialing pathways for adult
5	learners in technical and trade fields through courses run in the evening. Community college
6	based career technical institutes shall be required to meet the same standards for approval as
7	career technical institutes based in vocational technical schools, and shall be included in all
8	reports related to the Career Technical Initiative.
