In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to container safety on roadways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "certificate" the last time it
- 3 appears, the following words:-
- Any temporary non-reducible load, such a dumpsters, shipping containers and pods, that
- 5 are left in vehicular traffic areas, private or municipal lots or roadways, shall have reflective tape
- adhered to the unit as defined in the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's CFR 393.11.
