**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)**

An Act authorizing the Town of Avon to appoint a town clerk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: As of the effective date of this act, the elected incumbent town clerk shall
2 continue to serve in such elected position for the term for which she was elected. The town clerk
3 shall, during this period, be subject to the call of the appointing authority for the position as forth
4 in the Town of Avon Town Charter. Upon the expiration of such elected term, the elected office
5 shall be abolished; provided, however, that the elected incumbent holding office as of the
6 effective date of this act shall become the first appointed clerk under this Act. If the elected
7 incumbent removes from office prior to the expiration of the elected term, the elected position
8 shall thereupon be abolished and such office filled in accordance with appointing procedures as
9 set forth in the Town of Avon Town Charter.

10 SECTION 2: The Town of Avon Town Charter shall be amended by striking out the
11 existing Section 3-4(a) “Term of Office” and replacing said section with the following language
12 “Appointment, Term of Office - There shall be a town clerk, appointed by the Select Board, to
13 serve for a term of three years.”

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
