- 1 SECTION 1. Section 19 of Chapter 15A of the Massachusetts General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- The Board of Higher Education shall institute, in conjunction with the Board of
- 4 Education, a program to allow any public school teacher or paraprofessional presently working
- 5 in the Commonwealth to attend courses at public institutions of Higher Education in the
- 6 Commonwealth at no tuition cost.
