**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court  
(2025-2026)**

An Act relative to disclosure notice in the right to repair motor vehicle data law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of Chapter 93K of the General Laws, as most recently amended by Section 4 of  
2 Chapter 386 of the Acts of 2022, is hereby amended by striking subsections (g) and (h) and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following subsection (g):-

4 (g) The Attorney General is hereby directed to establish a motor vehicle telematics  
5 system notice which a vehicle manufacturer shall include in the owner’s manual provided for its  
6 new motor vehicles beginning with model year 2026 vehicles and which shall include the  
7 following information: (i) an explanation of motor vehicle telematics and its purposes; (ii) a  
8 description summarizing the mechanical data collected, stored, and transmitted by a telematics  
9 system; (iii) the prospective owner’s ability to access the vehicle’s mechanical data through a  
10 mobile device; and (iv) an owner’s right to authorize an independent repair facility to access the  
11 vehicle’s mechanical data for vehicle diagnostics, repair, and maintenance purposes.
