In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to fees at health clubs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 80 of chapter 93 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the last paragraph the following:-
- 3 "If a buyer becomes physically or medically disabled for a period in excess of three
- 4 months during the membership term, he or she shall have the option to be relieved of liability for
- 5 payment on that portion of the contract term for which the buyer is disabled, or to extend the
- 6 duration of the contract at no additional cost for a period equal to the duration of the disability.
- No contract shall impose any type of fee for a period of three months if the buyer
- 8 becomes physically and medically disabled and the disability is verified by a licensed physician."
