### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act requiring informed consent for marijuana testing.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after section 70H the following section:-
- 3 Section 70I. A facility, as defined in section 70E, physician or health care provider shall 4 not: (1) test any person for the presence of marijuana or delta-9-tetrahydricannabinol, also known 5 as THC, without first obtaining that person's written informed consent; (2) disclose the results of 6 such test to any person other than the subject of the test without first obtaining the subject's 7 written informed consent; or (3) identify the subject of such tests to any person without first 8 obtaining the subject's written informed consent. A written consent form shall state the purpose 9 for which the information is being requested and shall be distinguished from written consent for 10 the release of any other medical information.

- 11 Whoever violates this section shall be considered to have violated section 2 of chapter12 93A.
- For the purpose of this section "written informed consent" shall mean a written consent form for each requested test and release of the results of a test performed on an individual showing the presence of marijuana or THC or for the release of medical records containing such information.
