### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to loading and alighting vehicles from car carriers on public ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 Section 1
- 2 Chapter 90, Section 22b subsection (a) of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing

3 in the 2022 official edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection at the end

4 thereof:

No "low-boy automobile transporter" or "automobile transporter", as defined by
Massachusetts General Law, section 1 of Chapter 90, shall load or alight any motor vehicles for
delivery or transport to a dealer, as defined by section 1 of chapter 90, on any public way in the
commonwealth.

9 A violation of this section shall be cause for revocation of the common carrier permit 10 issued under chapter 159b section 4 and certificates authorizing operations of common carriers

- 11 issued under chapter 159b section 3 and the operator subject to penalties subject to section 22b
- 12 subsection A of chapter 90.
