## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act parental rights legislation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Local public school jurisdictions and school committees have the right to reject any and
- 2 all guidance and directives from DESE entirely or at the line item level without any fear of
- 3 reprisal in the form of faculty and administration losing their licensure, criminal referrals of
- 4 faculty, administration or school committee members, or the withholding of state funds. The
- 5 power to dictate all policy and procedure in local school jurisdictions is held by the school
- 6 committee members and the citizens and parents that elect them.
