## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to institutions of higher education.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 148 of Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after the words "engaged in agricultural work" when they first appear, the phrase "and
- 3 employees of nonprofit institutions of higher education."
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 148 of Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 5 inserting the following sentence: "With respect to any claim or cause of action seeking any legal
- or equitable remedy or relief commenced on or after July 1, 2024, a nonprofit institution of
- 7 higher education shall be immune from civil liability under claims alleging that the institution's
- 8 payment of wages on a monthly basis violated this Section."
