An Act Relative to PTSD and Accidental Disability.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision (3) of section 7 of chapter 32 of the general
- 2 laws, as appearing in the 2022 official edition, is hereby amended in line 182 by adding the
- 3 following paragraph:
- 4 Lapse of time or failure to file notice of an injury sustained or hazard undergone as
- 5 provided for in subdivision (1) of this section or subdivision (1) of section 9, as the case may be,
- 6 shall also not be a bar to proceedings under either of such sections if such members or
- 7 beneficiaries are filing for benefits under this section or section nine on the basis of an emotional
- 8 or psychological injury. In that case, such members or beneficiaries may use the official records
- 9 of the employer to establish proof of an injury sustained or hazard undergone. The official record
- must show that the member responded to and was directly involved in an incident or incidents.
- 11 The incident or incidents need not have occurred within 2 years of the date of application.
