**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court  
(2025-2026)**

An Act Relative to the Circular Economy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding, after section  
2 21, the following section:-

3 Section 21A. The department shall update state waste system plans to reflect and  
4 incorporate the following: the transition to a circular economy is a priority for the  
5 Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Circular economy is defined as an economy that keeps  
6 material, products, and services in circulation for as long as possible.

7 SECTION 2. Chapter 21 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding, after section  
8 67, the following section:-

9 Section 68. The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection shall create a  
10 circular economy education and outreach program. This education and outreach program shall:  
11 inform the public about what the circular economy is; inform the public on how they can  
12 participate in the transition to a circular economy; inform Massachusetts businesses on what the

- 13 circular economy is; inform Massachusetts businesses on how to participate in the transition to a
- 14 circular economy.
