In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act relative to the definition of podiatry.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out section 13, as so appearing, and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following section:-
- Section 13. (a) As used in this chapter, "podiatry" is the specialty that addresses the
- 5 diagnosis and treatment of pathologies and conditions of the leg, with special emphasis in the
- 6 diagnosis and treatment of the foot, ankle and their governing and related structures of the leg by
- 7 any and all means. Osseous surgical treatment is limited to that part of the leg at or distal to the
- 8 tibial tubercle.
- 9 (b) As used in sections 12B, 12G and 80B, "physician" shall include a podiatrist registered under section 16.
- 11 (c) Sections 13 to 18, inclusive, shall not apply to surgeons of the United States Army,
- 12 United States Navy or of the United States Public Health Service or to physicians registered in
- the commonwealth.
