### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act designating April 5 as Okur-Chung Neurodevelopmental Syndrome Awareness Day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after section 15ZZZZZZ, the following section:-
- 3 Section 15AAAAAAA. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart
- 4 April 5 as Okur-Chung Neurodevelopmental Syndrome (OCNDS) Awareness Day, to raise
- 5 awareness of this rare genetic disorder caused by heterozygous mutations in the CSNK2A1 gene
- 6 on chromosome 20 and manifesting as developmental delay or differences in brain function,
- 7 which can be managed with early therapy, and recommending that the day be observed in an
- 8 appropriate manner by the people.
